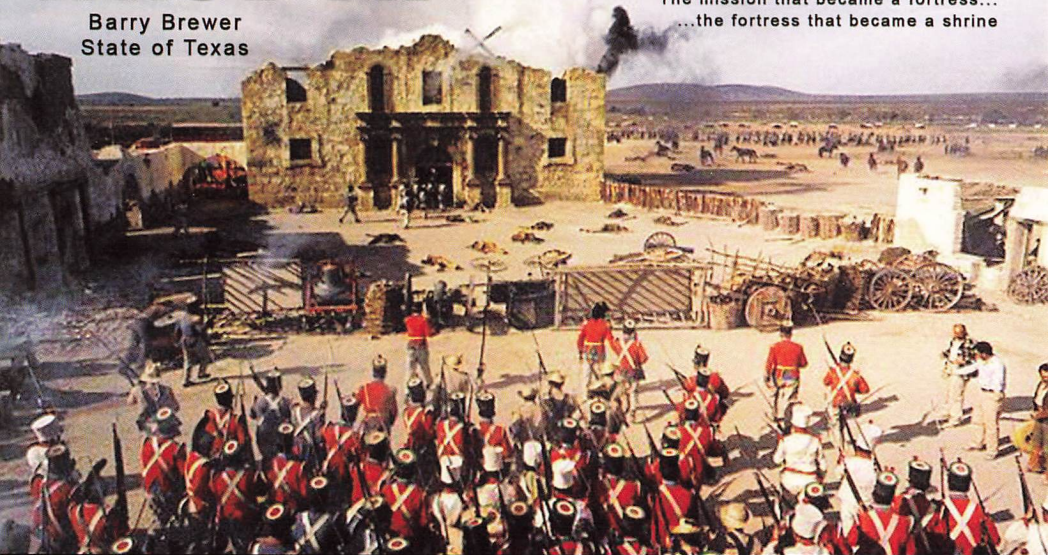

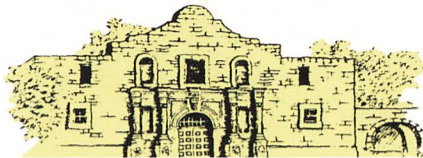

From February 23 to March 6, 1836, Davy Crocket, Jim Bowie, William B. Travis and 180 Texas loyalist withstood continual bombardment and attack from General Santa Anna and his 5000 Mexican army troops at the Alamo. Outnumbered 25 to 1, the defenders of the Alamo kept Santa Anna engaged long enough for Sam Houston to organize and train the Texas "army" which ultimately defeated Santa Anna at the Battle of San Jacinto on April 21, 1836, giving Texas it's independence from Mexico. The Alamo stands today as a tribute to the brave men who fought to their death to give birth to Texas.
